- Councillor's Report -
 - OCP Rockland doesn't have an LAP
 - open houses May 11 Atrium
 - Moss Market pop-up May 18
 - Many changes in Council working to apply Bill 44
 - City will be using Missing Middle planning rather than provincial bill
 - this is to our benefit
 - more rules about set-back etc. More liveable in the future.
 - The city is well ahead of others on provincial targets
 - there are different ways of counting: things that have already passed planning? Will they be finished before the target date is reached (3 years)? Some developments already in the works are huge and will house a thousand people. The result is that different numbers will appear in the press.
 - AH is there any measurement for how much housing there'll be for people who are struggling to afford housing?
 - MG no. Lots of stories, but no hard data. Very hard to calculate
 - There are not going to be any more density bonuses. There's an amenity charge (ACC). When there are new buildings, and housing is increased, there will be an amenity charge. Not sure about administration. The current thought is that it will be put in a big kittie. The city is going to create an amenity list for new amenities. If RNA is thinking of an amenity (park land); a community centre (enlargement necessary because of the population increase.) now is the time to put it on a SHORT list. The catch is that they're trying to gather information about desired amenities during the OCP surveys. Make a very careful list for presentation through the OCP process.
 - she's been busy working on getting rid of anti-semitic tagging, especially on private property (commercial building)
