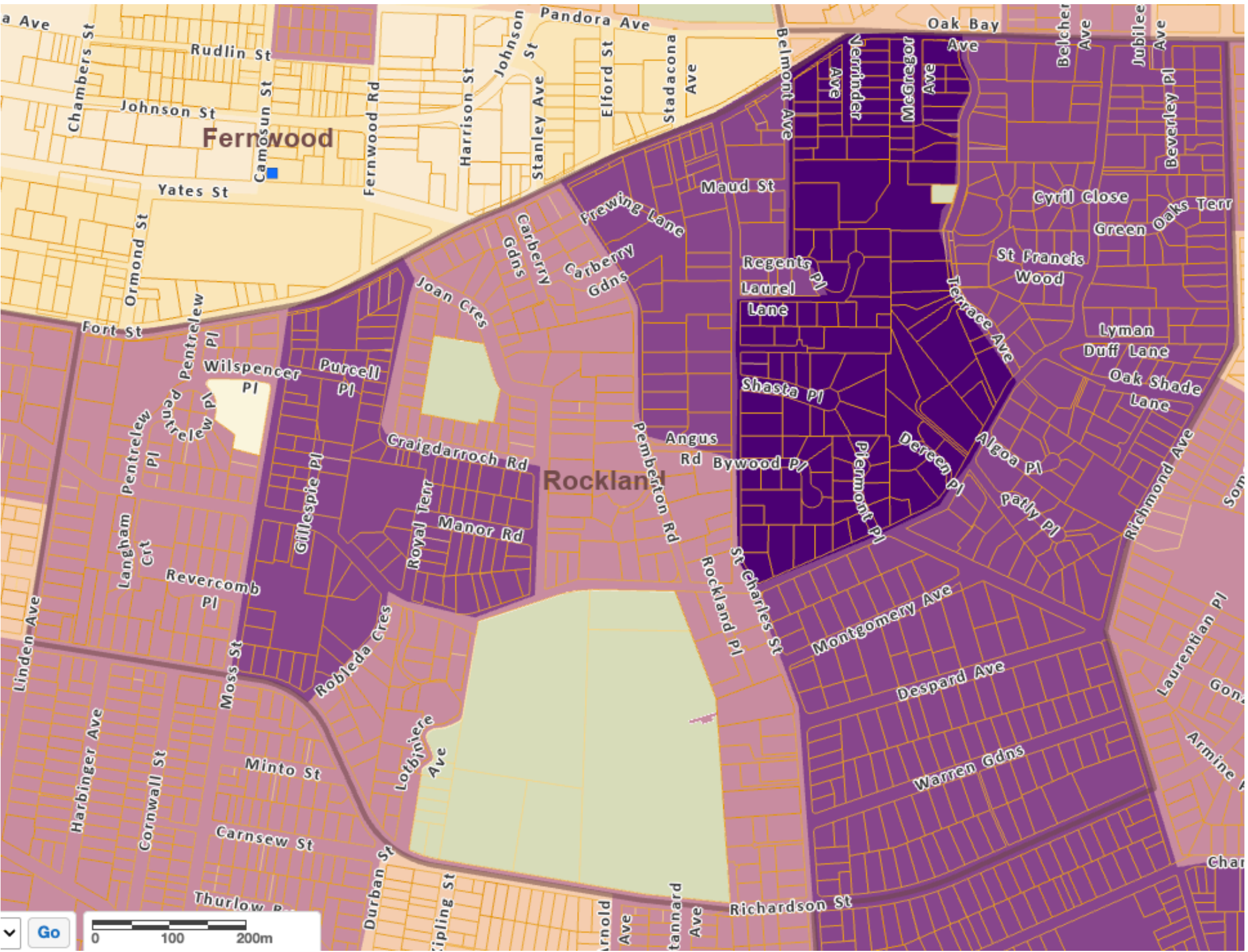

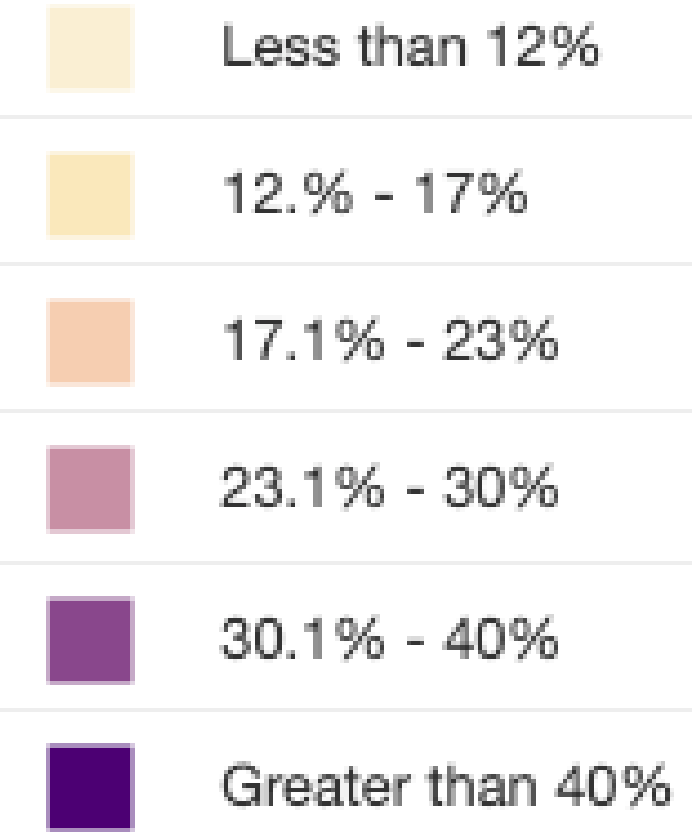

Where they live Seniors



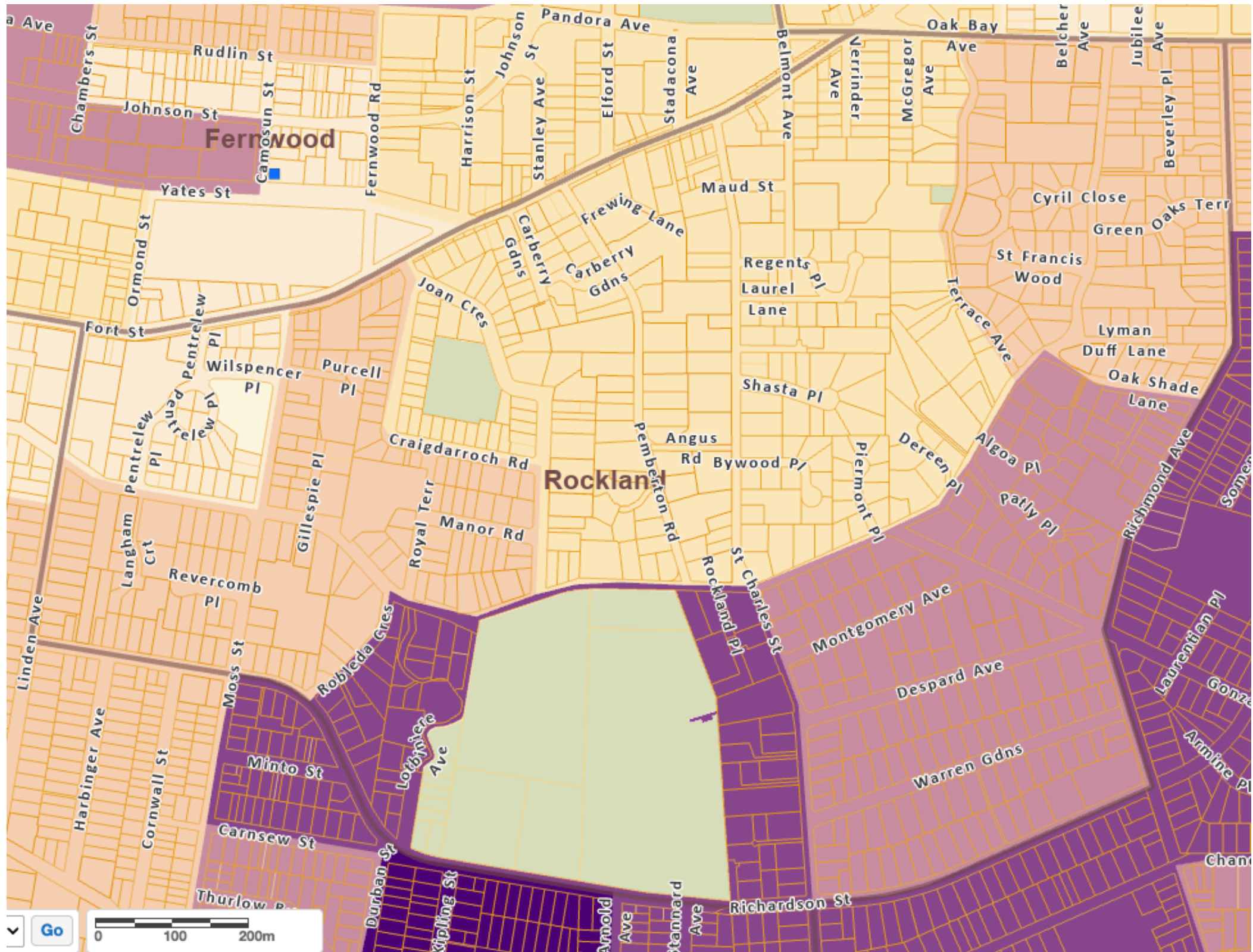

Victoria has far fewer visible minorities than the rest of British Columbia.

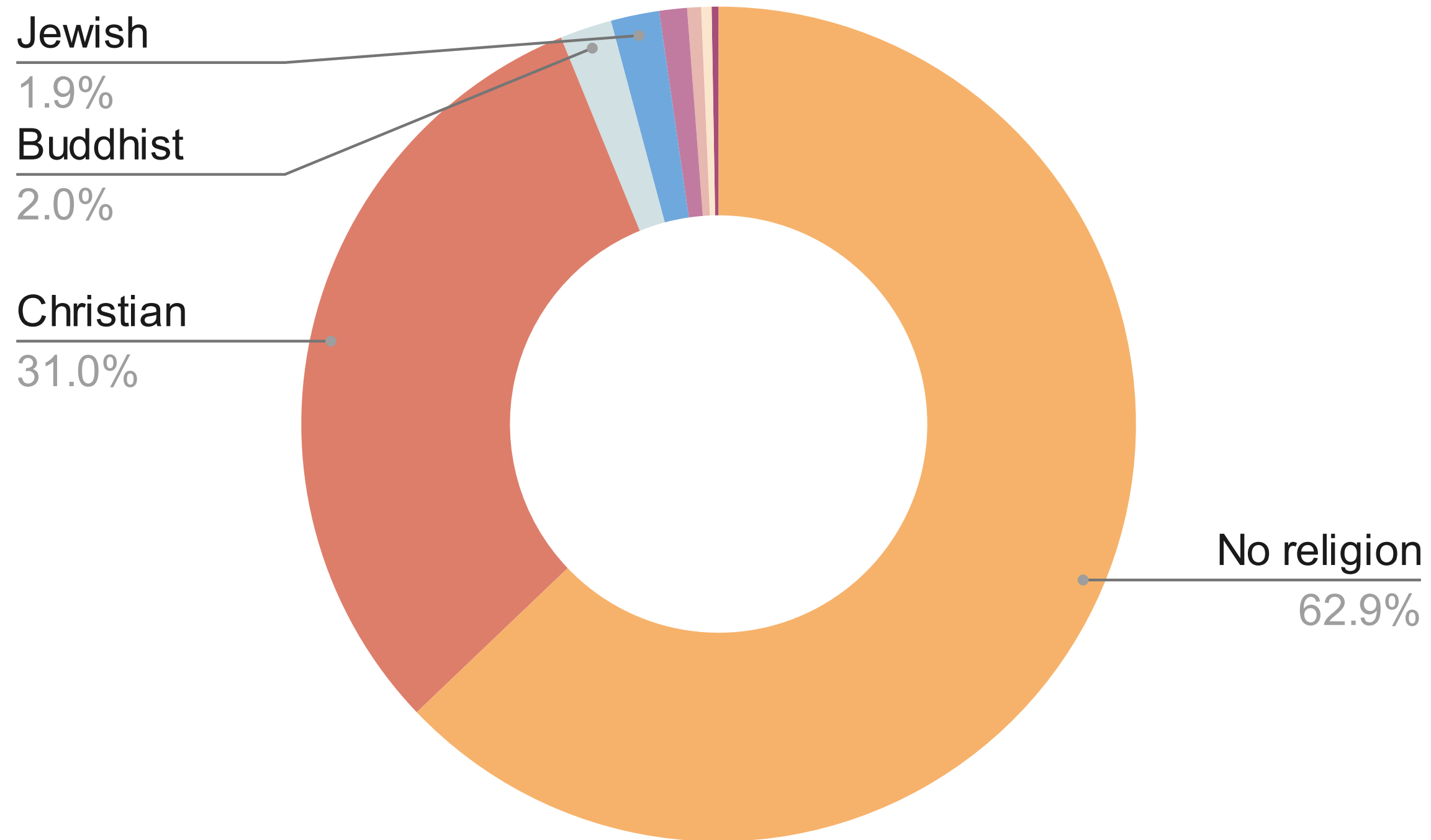

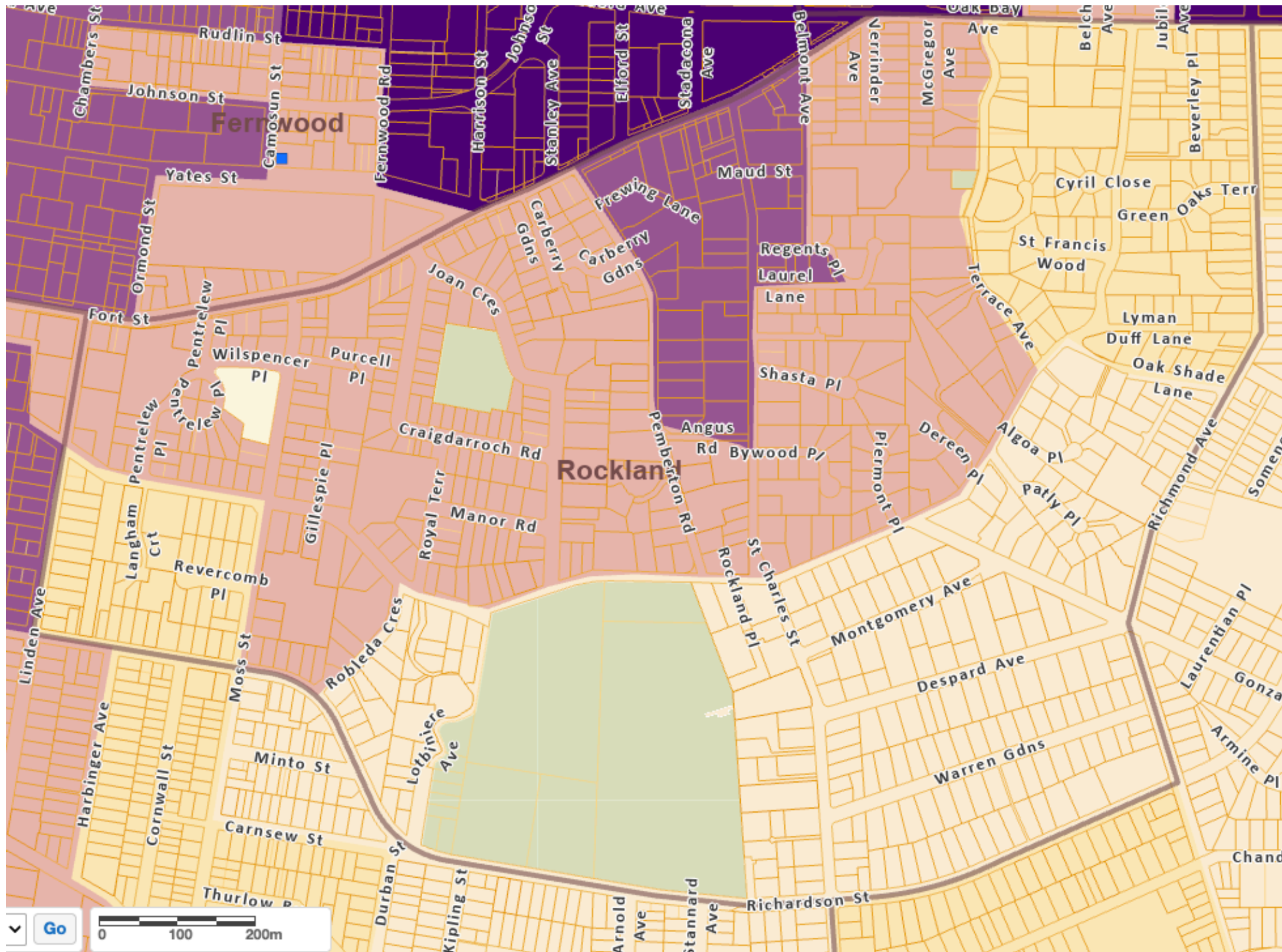

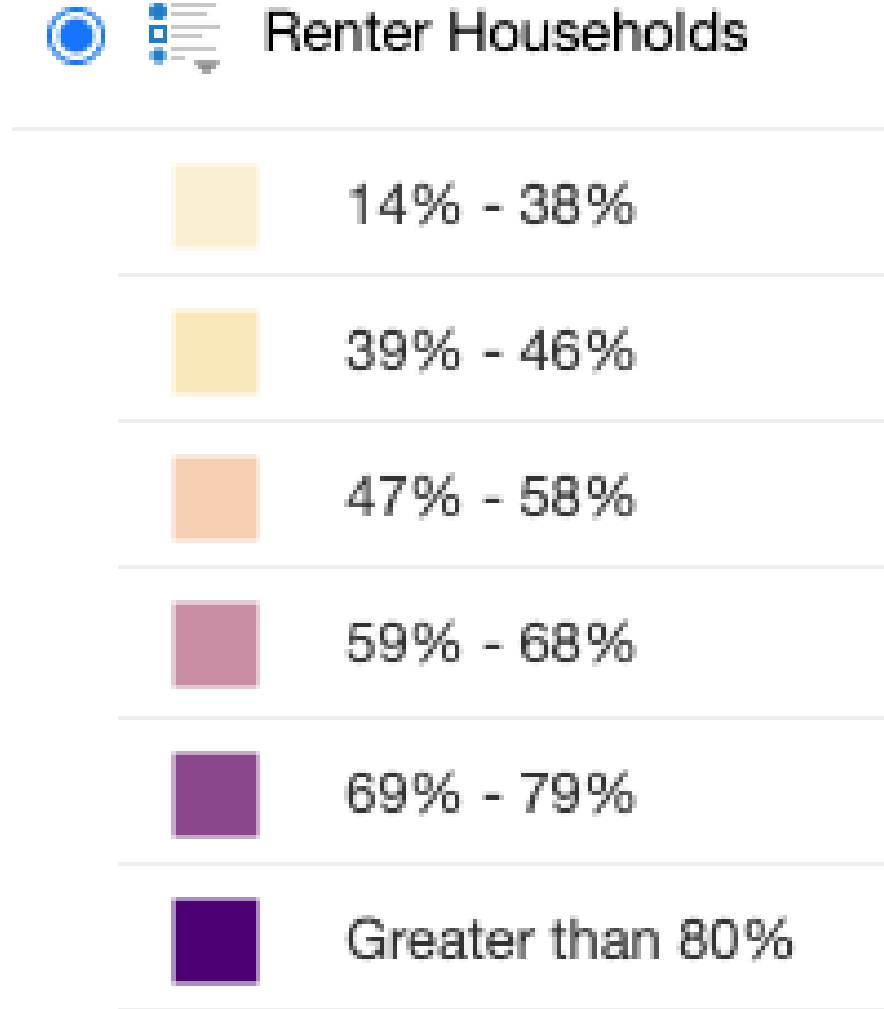
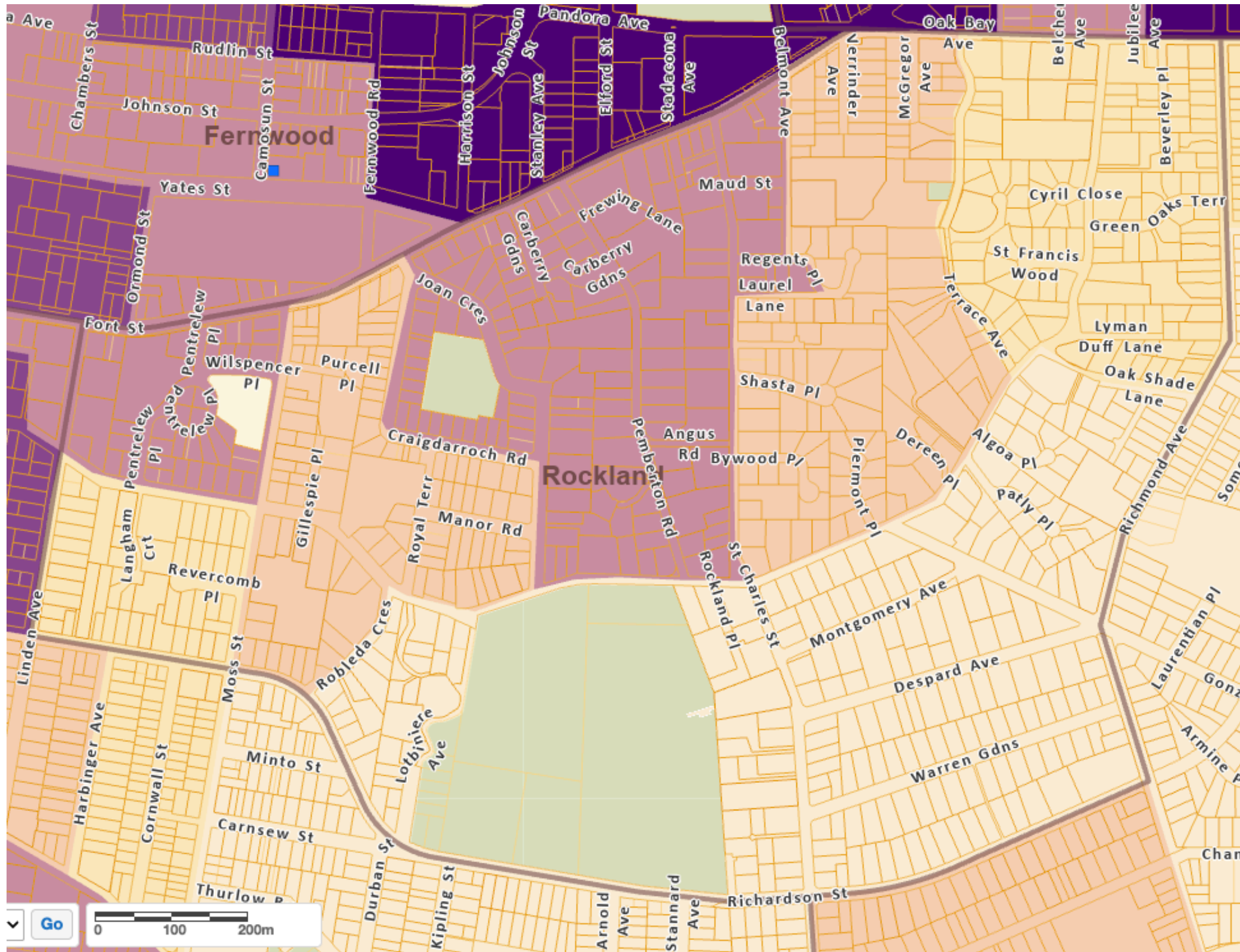

Concentration of Renter Households

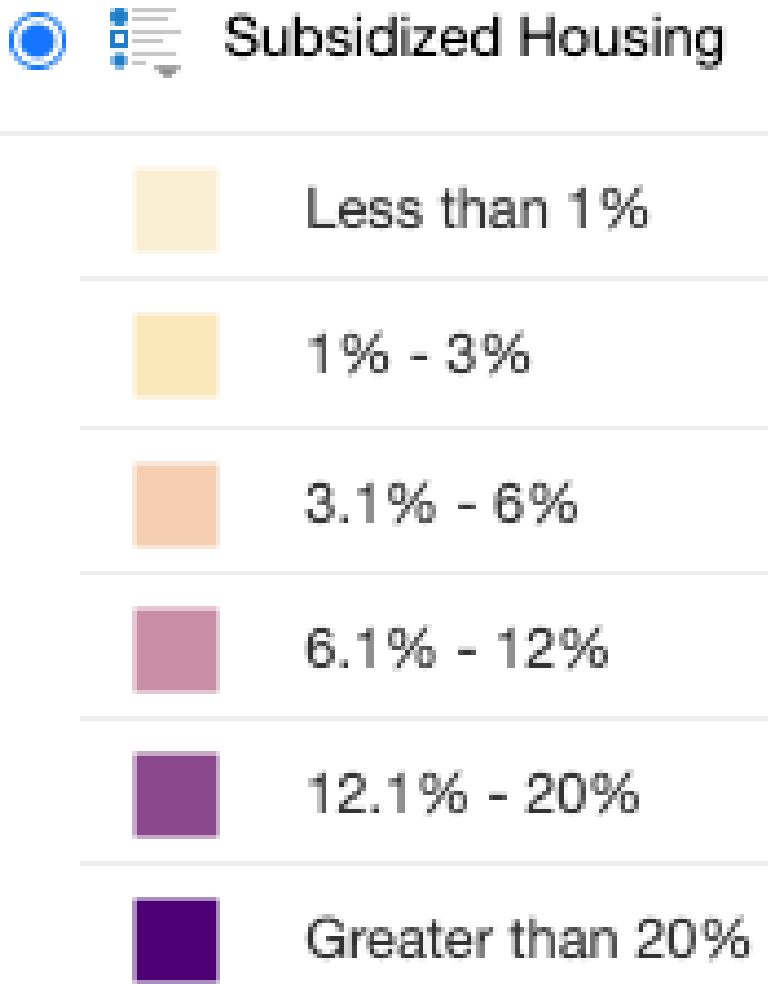
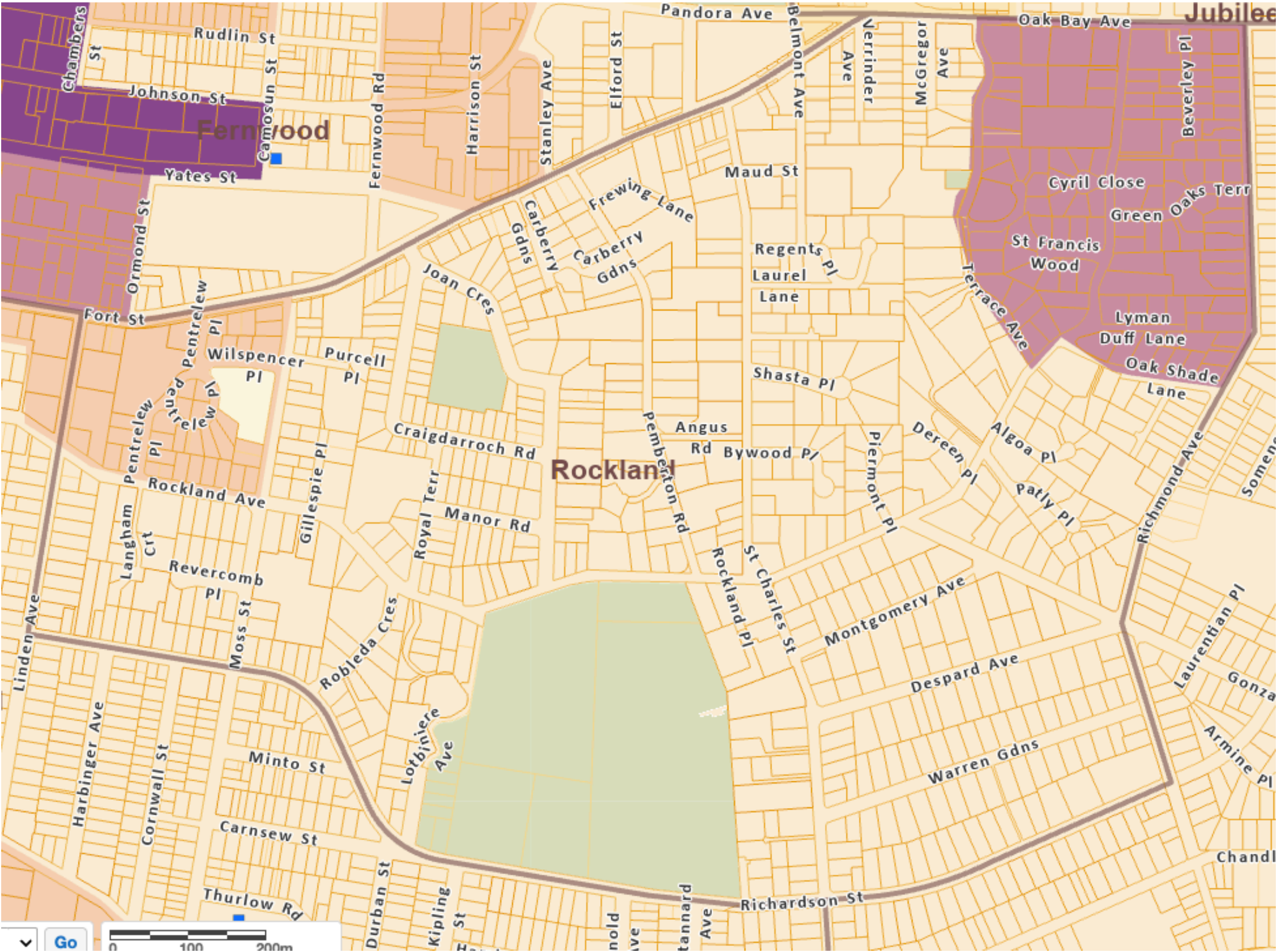

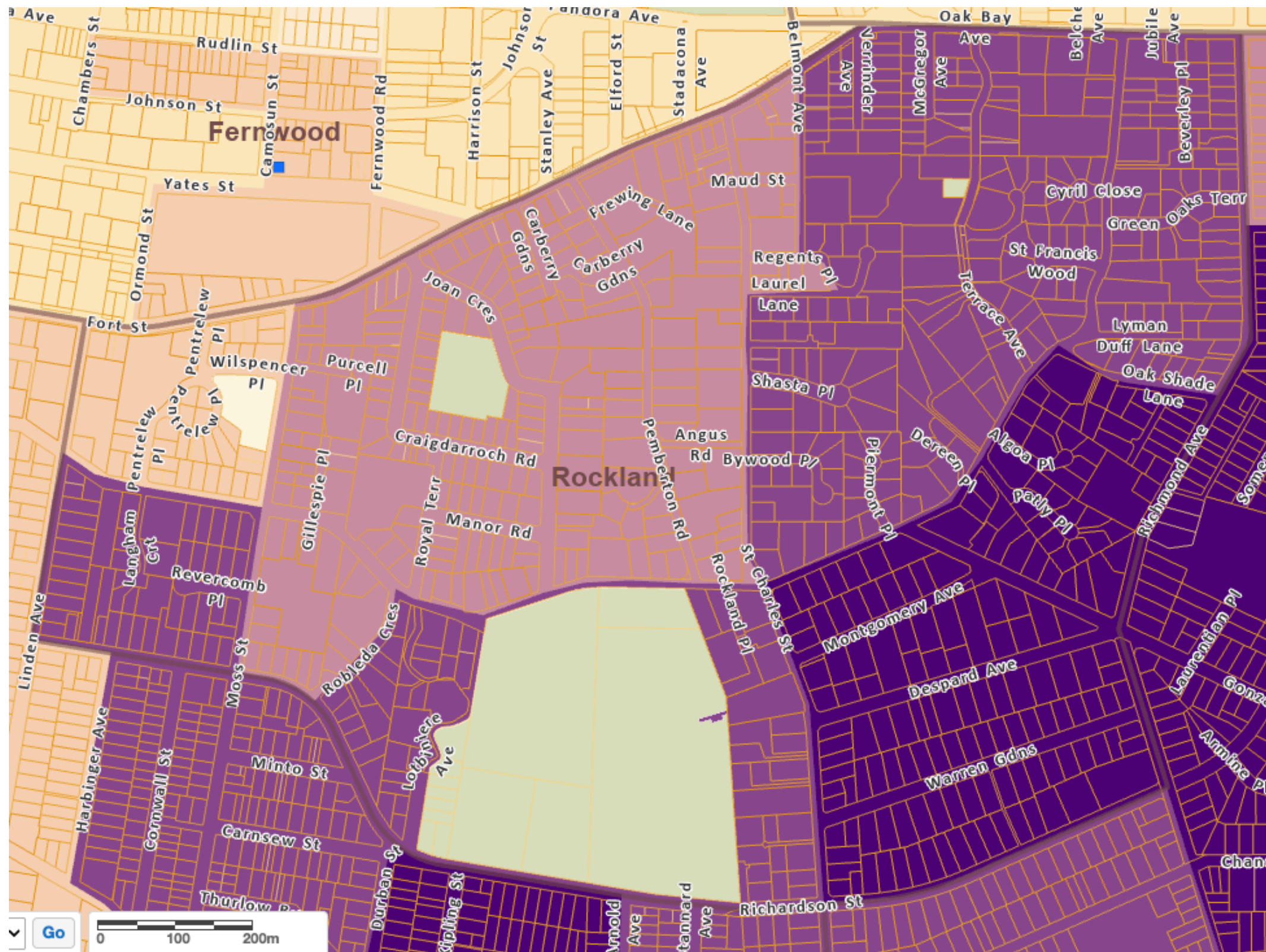

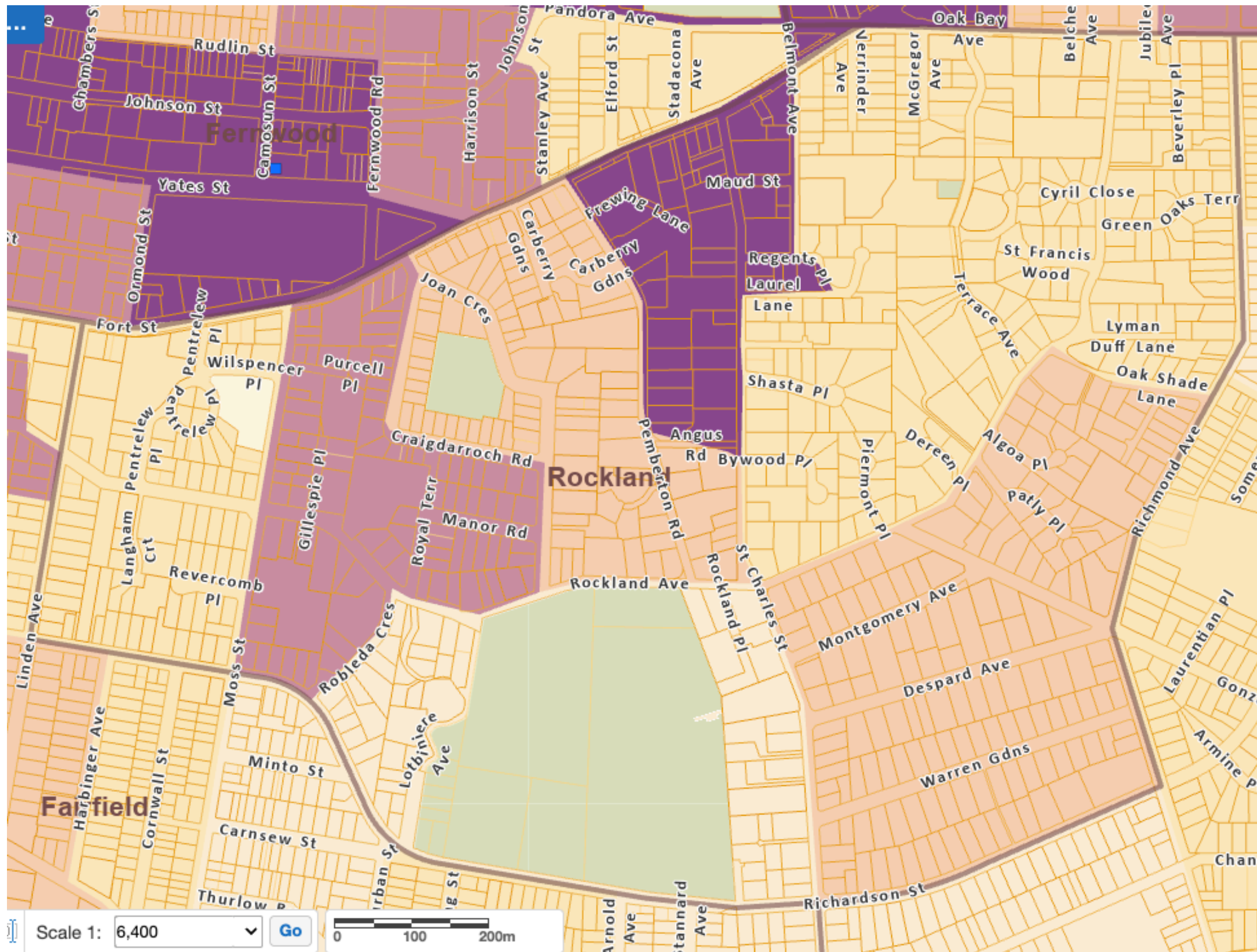
